Technical Assistance Opportunities for Institutions of Higher Education (updated April 2021)

In response to the pandemic, The Hope Center is currently offering four types of technical assistance to institutions:

- Institutional Capacity Building Cohort (ICBC)
- Coalitions (#RealCollegeCA and #RealCollegePHL)
- Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation Ecosystem support
- Individual Contracts
