

- Provide support and partnership to assess, analyze, and take action to improve students' basic needs security and well-being through research, training, coaching, & learning communities



HIP Coaching:

- Levels II & III only
- Adapts learning to individual institutional needs & context
- Supports Campus Lead to maximize impact of cross-department team
- Informs strategic action planning
- Taps into The Hope Center extended library of resources

How to Join HIP

Identify

Identify the level that best suits your institution



Appoint

Appoint one person to complete and submit the application



Prepare

Prepare your team based on your level of choice



Sign

Upon acceptance, sign the service agreement



Submit

Upon selection, issue the payment

Fee Structure

Based on services
provided at each level:

- Level I: \$14,000/yr
- Level II: \$19,000/yr
- Level III: \$24,000/yr

Consider HEERF and
SSARP funds.



Equity-Based Reduced Fee

The Hope Center recognizes the systemic resource inequities for institutions serving a high percentage of #RealCollege students and offers a discount of **\$5,000** per level per year for **HBCUs, Tribal, and community colleges.**


